

Your Waste Collection and Recycling Program

Waste Management of Ohio is proud to be your waste services provider. In this kit you will find complete information on how your new waste collection and recycling services work and the benefits you will enjoy.

Refuse Collection

Your weekly refuse service WILL NOT change. You have been provided a 96-gallon cart for the placement of your refuse (garbage, trash). Please place your carts at the curb not later than 6:00 a.m. the morning of your schedule pick up day. If you need an additional cart you may rent additional carts for \$3.00 per cart per month. Waste Management will bill you direct for all cart rentals. You may call Waste Management at 1-866-797-9018 to set up your additional cart rental.

PLEASE NOTE THAT WHILE THERE ARE SOME CHANGES IN YOUR SERVICE, YOUR TUESDAY COLLECTION DAY WILL REMAIN THE SAME.

Bulk Item Collection

Place all bulk items at the curb on the same day as your refuse. A bulk item is defined as: couch, sofa, stove, mattress, box spring, living room chairs, kitchen table, kitchen chairs, desk, end tables, washing machine or dryer, hot water heater and carpet (six (6) bundles of carpet, 2-feet in diameter by 4-feet in length and securely tied).

If you have an item that contains Freon (i.e. refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, air conditioners, etc.), you are required to schedule the pick-up of that item by calling the Village office (419-634-4045) at least 48 hours in advance of pick-up. Pick-up for these items are on the same day as your refuse service. A \$55 fee is to be paid prior to collection for each item containing freon. Fee is to be paid at the Water Department.

Yard Waste Collection

Yard waste materials can be placed in with your trash for collection. Yard waste includes grass, leaves and garden waste. Tree limbs will also be collected if they are bundled and tied in 4-foot lengths, are no more than 2-feet in diameter and weigh no more than 40 pounds.

Christmas trees will be picked up as part of the normal collection service at no additional charge. Remove all ornaments and lights, cut the tree in 6-foot lengths and place the pieces next to your bin or bag at the curb.



Your Every Other Week 64-Gallon Recycling Cart (SEE CALENDAR)

The Every-Other-Week Recycling program is easy. Simply refer to the calendar on the back of this brochure and look for the highlighted day. This will be the day you sit your 64-gallon recycling cart at the curb. It will be on Tuesdays unless there is a holiday.

Placing your cart out for collection:

REFER TO THE CALENDAR ON THE BACK PANEL FOR THE DAYS OF COLLECTION FOR YOUR NEW RECYCLING CART. Your cart should be placed out at the curb Monday evening after 6 p.m. Your cart should be placed two feet from the roadway with the lid opening facing towards the street. Do not place your cart in the street. Please place your recycling cart 18 inches or more from your 96-gallon trash cart to allow for proper servicing of your 64-gallon recycling cart. Do not place your cart close to obstructions such as mailboxes, utility poles, fire hydrants or parked cars.

Caring for your cart:

Your new Village of Ada cart is designed for ease of maintenance. To clean, simply rinse with water from time to time and let it dry in sunlight with the lid open. Do not place paints, solvents, acids, gasoline, oil, hot ashes, medical recyclables, exposed needles, sand, soil, rocks or concrete in your cart.
