- Senior senior Patrick Angle (Logan) hit junior Devon Price (Toledo/Start) on a 10-yard TD pass with :09 left to lift ONU

- Angle led Ohio Northern with 384 yards of total offense, rushing for 115 yards and a score and throwing for 269 yards and four scores.

- Price had 194 all-purpose yards for the Polar Bears and caught 10 passes for 123 yards and two scores.

- Trailing 28-17 entering the fourth quarter, ONU scored three TDs in the final 15 minutes to rally for the victory.

- With the win, ONU head coach Dean Paul becomes the only active coach to win a game at each of the 10 OAC schools.

- Northern got the ball on its own 25-yard line with 3:32 left in the game after BW regained a 35-31 lead.

- ONU marched 75 yards in 16 plays for the winning score, converting two third downs and two fourth downs on the drive.

Angle to Price with :09 left leads Gridders to 37-35 win

- This marks the second time this season that Ohio Northern has rallied from a large early deficit, as ONU came from 17-0 behind to win at Washington (Mo.) 31-24 on Sept. 6. - Angle scored on a 56-yard run on the first play of the fourth quarter to pull ONU within 28-24. - He then hit sophomore Reed Allen (Whitehouse / Anthony Wayne) on a 25-yard TD pass with 10:41 left in the game to give Northern its first lead of the game at 31-28.
