#### Women's Cross Country

**Record:** 69-59 Overall

**Last Week:** 5th of 10 with 114 points at OAC Championships at JCU, Sat.

**This Week:** Idle.

**Notes:**

- The Ohio Northern women's cross country team (69-59 overall) finished 5th of 10 teams with 114 points at the OAC Championships at Gates Mills, Ohio.

- Seniors **Samantha Hoffman (Helena/Gibsonburg)** and **Raechel Moore (Commerce, Mich./Lakeland)** earned All-OAC honors by posting top-18 finishes at the meet.

- Hoffman led ONU across the finish line with a 10th place finish out of 125 runners over the 6,000-meter course in 24:55.

#### Hoffman, Moore earn All-OAC honors at OAC Championships

- Moore finished 17th in 25:21.

- Junior **Kara Sosinski (Hudson)** was 31st in 25:54, freshman **Alexis Kandel (Big Prairie/West Holmes)** was 32nd in 25:56 and freshman **Emily Richards (Delaware/Hayes)** was 33rd in 26:02 for Ohio Northern.

- Mount Union won the OAC championship team title with 24 points, Otterbein was second with 69 points, John Carroll third with 89 points, Heidelberg was fourth with 100 points, and Ohio Northern rounded out the top five with 114 points.

- Ohio Northern will take next weekend off in preparation for the NCAA Div. III regional's Nov. 15 at Wilmington.

#### Men's Cross Country

- The Ohio Northern men's cross country team (93-28 overall) finished third out of 10 teams at the 2014 OAC Championships at Gates Mills.

- This marks the 10th consecutive season that the Polar Bears have finished in the top three at the OAC Championships.

- Senior **Nathan Rosenbaum (Orrville)** led the Polar Bears across the finish line, finishing third with a time of 26:48.59. With the third place finish, Rosenbaum has earned 1st Team All-Conference for the third time in his career, and

marks his fourth time earning All-Conference honors.

- Sophomore **Andrew Harden (Vandalia / Butler)** finished 10th in the race and earned 2nd Team All-Conference honors finishing in 27:41.63. This is Harden's first career OAC All-Conference honor.

- Also finishing in the top 25 runners for the Polar Bears were junior **Eric Wyner (North Baltimore/Van Buren)**, who was 21st in 28:01.92 and freshman **Bobby Borger (Perrysburg)** who was 25th in 28:09.84.

- Northern will be back in action as they compete in the NCAA Division III Regional Meet at Wilmington on November 15th.

- ONU's defense played extremely well throughout the contest and especially in the first half, limiting MC to just 12 yards of total offense and zero first downs as the Pioneers went 3-and-out on all seven of its first half possessions.  
- Northern held MC to just 112 yards of total offense, including just 41 through the air.  
- Junior **Justin Magazine (Warren/Harding)** ran 25 times for 116 yards and a TD to lead the ONU offense and **Justin Tello (Land O'Lakes, Fla.)** and senior **Malcolm Burrell (Columbus / DeSales)** each had seven tackles to lead the stout Polar Bear defense.

**Dial-Roberson Stadium, Ada, Ohio**

**Series:** ONU leads the all-time series between the two schools by a 23-3 margin. ONU leads the series 12-2 in games played in Ada. ONU has won the last 20 games in the series, including a 52-10 victory at Wilmington in 2013.

**ONU coach Dean Paul:** Paul in his 11th season at ONU with a 73-37 record. He is 113-49 in 15 seasons overall and is 10-0 against WC.

**WC coach Stacey Hairston:** Hairston is in his second season at WC with an 0-18 record. He is 0-1 against ONU.

**Today's Contest:** Today's game is the final home game of the season and is Senior Day for the Polar Bears. Northern will be looking to extend its current winning streak over the Quakers to 21 games, dating to a 14-12 win in 1957.

**Last Year's Game:** QB **Patrick Angle** completed 21-of-26 passes for 276 yards and 3 TDs and ran 10 times for 32 yards and another score to lead Ohio Northern to a 52-10 win at Wilmington. WR **Devon Price** caught eight passes for 128 yards and a TD and RB **Justin Magazine** carried 16 times for 48 yards and a pair of scores for the Polar Bears. DB **Josh Bryan** had a team-high 7 tackles and a PBU to lead the Northern defense. After fumbling on its first possession, ONU scored on its next eight possessions to put the game away. LB **Dillon Kwiat**, DB **Dan Eller** and DB **Austin Hostetler** lead the ONU defense with 61, 54 and 48 tackles, respectively.

**WC Last Week:** Heidelberg had 494 yards of total offense and defeated Wilmington 53-10 at Wilmington. K **Grant Brown** put WC on the board with a 21-yard field goal as time expired in the first half. WR **Justin Lee** took a toss from QB **Kyle Davis** and then promptly hit a streaking WR **Tyrik Burns** for a 26-yard touchdown pass with 3:26 left in the game. HU led 15-0 after the first quarter, 39-3 at halftime and 53-3 after three quarters. LB **Nick Winters** had 7 tackles, a forced fumble and an interception and DB **Eric Watts** had 7 tackles, a forced fumble and a PBU to lead the WC defense.

## Men's Swimming & Diving

**Last Week:** Won 114-91 H v Wilmington, Fri.; Lost 43-182 at #2 Kenyon, Sat.

**This Week:** H v Findlay and Defiance, Fri.

**Notes:**

- The Ohio Northern men's swimming & diving team (2-1 overall, 2-0 OAC) opened the home portion of its dschedule with a 114-91 win over Wilmington on Fri. and fell 182-43 at #2 Kenyon on Sat. last week.
- Against WC, Northern won only three of the nine swimming events, but captured both relays and used its depth to run its OAC regular season winning streak to 28 matches.
- Clinging to an 87-82 lead, sophomore **John Raker (Lebanon/Lakota West)** won the 100 breast in 1:01.96, leading a 1-2-4-5 ONU finish in the final individual race of the night to increase the lead to 103-85.
- Northern then won the 200 free relay as sophomore **Eric Chen (Mason)** rallied in the final leg for the victory to close out the meet.

## ONU men run OAC dual meet winning streak to 28 with 114-91 win over Wilmington

- Chen won the 50 free in :22.04, freshman **Trevor Keriazes (Springfield)** won the 200 I.M. in 2:01.23 and sophomore **Jeremy Preston (Painesville/Harvey)** won the 100 fly in :52.98 to give ONU a 66-46 lead.
- But the Quakers rallied and won the next three events to pull within 87-82 with just two events remaining.
- But Raker led a 1-2-4-5 in the 100 breast for ONU by winning in 1:01.96 to put the meet out of reach.
- At Kenyon, Preston led the Polar Bears as he won the 100 yard fly in 52.11 seconds.
- Chen earned second place in the 100 yard free in 47.97 seconds.
- The Polar Bears will host Findlay and Defiance in a tri-meet on Fri.

- Tingley won the 1000 free in 11:43.07, Chapman won the 100 back in 1:03.18 and Collopy won the 1-meter diving unopposed with 129.60 points.
