- The Ohio Northern men's cross country team (105-6 Overall) won the ten team OAC Championships with 39 points on Sat.

- This marks the 11th consecutive season that the Polar Bears have finished in the top three at the OAC Championships and fourth time they have won the Championship dating back to the 2004 season.

- Seven ONU runners earned All-Conference honors with top-18 finishes.

- Junior **Andrew Harden (Vandalia/Butler)** led the Polar Bears across the finish line, finishing

4th of 139 runners in 25:22 over the 8,000-meter course.

- Also earning All-OAC honors for the Polar Bears were sophomore **Bobby Borger (Perrysburg)** in 7th in 25:29.6, junior **Kase Schalois (Van Wert)** in 8th in 25:32.2, senior **Eric Wymer (North Baltimore/Van Buren)** in 9th in 25:32.5, freshman **Ian McVey (Stow/Stow-Munroe Falls)** in 11th in 25:41.8, sophomore **Matt Molinaro (Sterling Heights, Mich./DeLaSalle)** in 12th in 25:44.5 and junior **Aaren Hemmelgarn (Celina/Saint Henry)** in 17th in 25:55.7.

**Series:** ONU leads the all-time series between the two schools by a 27-23-2 margin. ONU has won the last three meetings, including a 31-10 decision last year in Ada.

**ONU coach Dean Paul:** Paul in his 12th season at ONU with an 80-39 record. He is 120-51 in 16 seasons overall and is 11-0 against WC.

**WC coach Stacey Hairston:** Hairston is in his third season at WC with a 1-26 record. He is 5-32 in four seasons overall and is 0-2 against ONU.

**Today's Contest:** Today's game is the ninth game of the year overall and the fourth and final road game for ONU. It is also the final home game and is Senior Day at Wilmington.

WR **Devon Price** caught seven passes for 111 yards and a score and became ONU's all-time receptions leader. QB **Patrick Angle** completed 16-of-27 passes for 281 yards and three touchdowns and RB **Justin Magazine** ran 12 times for 112 yards and a score for ONU. With the score tied at 3-3 after the first period, ONU outscored WC 40-5 in the middle 30 minutes to lead 43-8 entering the fourth quarter. ONU out-gained WC 560-269 in total offense. Defensively, LB **Dillon Kwiat** had a game-high 11 tackles and had an interception to lead ONU.

**ONU Last Week:** ONU rolled to a 62-21 victory over Marietta on Halloween Night on Saturday at Dial-Roberson Stadium. The Polar Bears improve to 6-2 overall and are 5-2 in Ohio Athletic Conference play, while the Pioneers fall to 1-7, 1-6. RB **Justin Magazine** ran 24 times for a career-high 200 yards and a TD and WR **Devon Price** caught 10 passes for a career-high 182 yards and three TDs, but QB **Ricardo Johnson** may have had the biggest night of all for the ONU offense. Johnson completed 13-of-19 passes for a career-high 235 yards and 3 TDs and ran 10 times for a career-high 106 yards and

three more touchdowns. In all, Johnson accounted for 341 yards and six touchdowns. He had TD runs of 20, 9 and 20 yards and TD passes of 27, 10 and 28 yards to Price. On defense, LB **Trent Stout** had a career-high 18 tackles and S **Justin Tello** had a career-high 13 tackles for the Polar Bears. The Polar Bears would score on 10 of their first 11 possessions, amassing 618 yards of total offense on the night. ONU led 17-7 after the first quarter, 31-14 at halftime and 52-14 after three periods of play.

LB **Zach Schmerge**, S **Dan Eller** and LB **Trent Stout** lead the ONU defense with 85, 72 and 63 tackles, respectively. DE **Kyle Beverly** leads ONU with 3.5 sacks.

**WC Last Week:** Wilmington turned the ball over seven times, five via interceptions, and fell to Heidelberg 44-0 Saturday. Heidelberg scored twice in the final 1:16 of the first half to double its lead from 15-0 to 30-0 to seize control of the game.
