Football playoff run ends with

42-7 loss at #3 UW-Oshkosh

### **Football**

**Record:** 9-3 Overall, 7-2 OAC (t2nd) **National Ranking:** Receiving Votes (D3football.com)

**Last Week:** Lost 7-42 at NCAA III Playoffs - 2nd Round at #3 Wisconsin-Oshkosh, Sat. **This Week:** Season Complete.

#### **Notes:**

- The Ohio Northern football team (9-3 Overall) saw its playoff run come to an end with a 42-7 loss at No. 3-ranked Wisconsin-Oshkosh in the Second Round of the NCAA Division III Football Playoffs on a sunny but chilly Sat. at Titan Stadium.
- Sophomore Ricardo Johnson (Saint Paul, Minn/Cretin-Derham-Hall) completed 10-of-20 passes for 71 yards and ran 21 times for 82 yards and senior Justin Magazine (Warren/Harding) ran 20 times for 84 yards and a TD to lead the ONU offense.
- The Polar Bears drove inside the Titans' 30yard line on each of their first three possessions,

but came away with only seven points.

- Meanwhile, Oshkosh took advantage of all three of its first half scoring opportunities and led 21-7 at halftime.
- UWO then scored on its first two possessions of the third quarter to take a 35-7 lead and went on to the victory.
- "We knew there would not be much margin for error against such a good opponent," ONU head coach Dean Paul said. "Congrats to Oshkosh. We did not take advantage of our scoring opportunities and they did. Our guys battled hard, but we just made too many mistakes."
- Defensively, senior **Justin Tello** (**Land O'Lakes**, **Fla.**) had 10 tackles to lead ONU.
- Ohio Northern held the ball for 37:09 and had 286 yards of total offense, while UWO had an even 400 yards of total offense.

- Senior Connor Devine (Marysville), Matt Chaney (Bryan) and Rody Seballos (Brecksville/Brecksville-Broadview Heights) and sophomores Cyler Caldwell (Wadsworth), Landry Hostetler (Strasburg/Strasburg-Franklin), Carter Kemper (Brecksville/ Brecksville-Broadview Heights) and Sam Shook (New Philadelphia) all earned the award.
- **Devine** is a four-year starter at long snapper and is also the back-up QB for the Polar Bears.
- He is making his second appearance on the Academic All-OAC team.
- This season, Devine is 5-of-6 passing for 40 yards and is 30-of-41 passing for 310 yards and three TDs in his career.
- **Chaney** is a three-year starter as a placekicker, handling kickoffs and long field goals for the past two seasons.
- He is also a two-time Academic All-OAC honoree.
- **Chaney** is 3-for-6 on field goals this season,

which includes a pair of 46-yarders.

- In his career, Chaney is 6-of-16 with a long of 49 yards and has scored 40 kicking points.
- **Seballos** is a three-year starter at left tackle and is a three-time Academic All-OAC honoree.
- He played in 34 games with 32 career starts.
- All four of the sophomores are making their first appearances on the Academic All-OAC team.
- He was named First Team All-OAC this year.
- **Caldwell** has played in 10 games as a reserve corner back and is a regular on special teams.
- He has nine tackles (seven solo) and has recovered a fumble this Fall.
- **Hostetler** played in two games at safety before an injury ended his season prematurely.
- In his two seasons at ONU, Hostetler has three tackles and a blocked punt in 8 career games.
- **Kemper** is a two-year regular on the two-deep at offensive tackle.
- He has appeared in one game at tackle.
- **Shook** has started all 12 games at right tackle for the Polar Bears in 2015.
- He has appeared in 13 games in his career after spending much of his freshman season on the two-deep.
- The Polar Bears were 9-3 overall and finished second in the OAC with a 7-2 league record in 2015 under 12th-year head coach Dean Paul.
