



Master Gardener Volunteer Training

SELF-PACED ONLINE COURSE WITH IN-PERSON EVENING CLASSES

Hardin County OSU Extension will host a Master Gardener Volunteer training course for new Master Gardener Volunteers this winter. The Ohio State University Extension Master Gardener Volunteer Program provides intensive training in horticulture to interested Ohio residents who then volunteer their time assisting with educational programs and activities for Ohio residents through their local Ohio State University Extension county office. Training will be a combination of a self-paced online course combined with in-person classes held at the Hardin County Extension office beginning with orientation on Tuesday, January 25 from 6:00-9:00 pm. Other scheduled in-person classes are February 1 and 15, March 1, 15, and 29 from 6:00-9:00 pm. New interns will gain hands-on training working alongside current Master Gardeners at the Friendship Gardens in Kenton. The training course is open to interested volunteers from any county with the volunteer commitment to be completed in the volunteer's home county program.
